The Sound of Silence is een nummer van Simon & Garfunkel, dat in september 1965 als single werd uitgegeven door Columbia Records. Het nummer werd geschreven door Paul Simon. Het liedje gaat over een jongeman die niet kan communiceren met zijn medemens. Art Garfunkel vatte de betekenis van het nummer ooit samen als "The inability of people to communicate with each other, not particularly internationally but especially emotionally". ("*Het onvermogen van mensen om met elkaar te communiceren, niet bijzonder internationaal maar vooral emotioneel*")


